



COMMERCIAL DEPARTMENT


Role:



Nalanda

Probably the oldest university in India, Nalanda is an important site to visit in Bihar. It is believed that the last and most famous Jain Tirthankara, Mahavira spent 14 monsoon seasons here. Today most parts of Nalanda lie in ruins but the place is surely worth exploring!

How to Reach?

Patna

Pawapuri

An important Jain pilgrimage, Jalmandir is situated in Pawapuri, Bihar. Jalmandir has been revered highly by Jain devotees as it is believed that it is the place where Lord Mahavira breathed his last in 500 BCE. It is reckoned to be the cremation ground for this last Tirthankara of Jain sect.

Rajgir (historically known as Rājagṛiha), meaning "the City of Kings", is an ancient city The city of Rajgir was the first capital of the kingdom of Magadha, a state that would eventually evolve into the Mauryan Empire.

Patna Sahib

Takht Sri Patna Sahib also known as Takhat Sri Harimandir Ji, is a Gurdwara. It was to commemorate the birthplace of Guru Govind Singh, the tenth Guru of the Sikhs on December 1666. It was built by Maharaja Ranjit Singh (1780-1839), The current shrine of Patna Sahib or Takht Sri Harmandirji Sahib was built in the 1950s.

Buxar Fort

Buxar Fort is a fort located in Buxar, Bihar, India. The fort was established by King Rudra Deo in 1054. The city is known for its cultural heritage as it is the place where Lord Rama killed the demon Taraka and also the site of Sage Vishvamaitra's Ashram.
