

	Eligibility Criteria	(A) General Capabilty: (1) Vendor /chemist/medical store shops should exist (submit/provide copy of valid licence held for above premises.) (2) Chemist/Vendor must hold valid drug licence as on the case of submission of bid in specified form issued by the caug controller authority of the uttar Pradesh under the provisions of Drug and cosmetics Act, 1940. The successful Bidder will further ensure that their licence remain valid till the end of t the contract period. (3) Chemist/Vendor should have valid licence/legal/local formalities for establishment as well as skilled manpower. (4) Vendor /chemist/medical store shops should have proper storage requirement and old chain systems.

(5) Having copy of valid GST registration certificate. (6) Having Copy of Valid Trade licence. (7) Copy of PAN allotted to the firm. (8) Vendor /chemist/medical store shops must not have been convicted by the central/state government authority and no case should be pending under the DRUG AND COSMETIC Act and rules. (9) Copy of details of registration with any government/private/corporate hospital and past experience of supply to Gov. Private/Corporate(if any) (B) Financial Capabilty: (1) Average turn over of the vendor for the last three completed financial year prior to date of opening of tender should be equal to or more than three times the average value of retail local purchase made by DRH/DDU in the last three completed financial year or three times the estimated annual value of purchase, whichever is higher. (2) Vendor should show profit in at least two out of three last financial year, Balance sheet/profit-loss account certified by CA should be called for this purpose. 10. Supply Conditions: (1). Service should be available 24X7. (2). Order will be placed through email/sms/whatsapp/HMIS to the (3). Material will have to be supplied within 24 hrs preferably before the closure of OPD, if the indent has been placed at least 4 hrs before closure of OPD timings. (4) For life saving drugs the firm has to supply within short notice preferably within in one hrs of being intimated. (5) Branded items should be supplied with the same name and brand only, no alternate or substitute will be accepted except with special permission of CMS/ECR/DDU. (6). Performance register will be maintained by the concerned store pharmacist. The Vendor or its representative while making deliveries will sign (with date and time) on register or receipt challan. The authorized representative of the ventor making supply can see the performance register. Entries in the register shall be final and shall not be put to question in any dispute. (7) Failure to supply in time, quantity and quality shall be recorded. (8). Vendor should Supply the medicines as per storage conditions. item will be not acceptable if found without proper storage condition and it will be recorded in performance register. (9). Vendor shall Indemnify the railway administatrion for any loss or liabilities arising due to defective/sub standard supplies by the vendor. (10). Medicines or any other related items should be supplied

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


(11). Store Pharmacist shall have right to ask the vendor to show the purchase bill for the medicine other items to ensure

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genuineness of the item being supplied. (12) The offer of given discount on MRP will be valid for the
period of validity of rate contract including extended period if any. (13) Order for supply after selection of successful panel of
letter.
(14) If the vendor fails to supply as per contarct condition the particular item shall be procured from the other empanelled vendor or in case of urgency it can be purchased from open market and difference in cost will be recoverd from the vendor to whom the order is placed.
(15) Supply/Delivery of the items shall be done as per the local requirements.
(16) CMS/DDU reserves the right to send the drugs etc supplied in L.P. to be tested byGovt and other approved testing laboratories and, if required, to inform Drug Controller for
suitable action. (17) The offer of given discount on MRP will be valid for the entire period of validity of rate contract including the extended period if any.
(18) Vendor shall indemnify the Railway administration for any loss or liabilities arising due to defective/sub-standard supplies by the vendor.
 (19) Timeline for supply should be strictly followed. (1) To avoid failure of supply in hospital, as per the need, Rate contract may be entered with more than one vendor for local purchase as per need.
 (2) Decision in this regard shall be taken by CMS/DDU. (3) Quantity to be ordered against rate contracts shall be graded in relation to discounts offered by vendors i.e. L1 will get the maximum supply orders. In case of two vendor's distribution of orders (value wise) should be in the ratio of 70:30 on
monthly basis or Suitable methodology may be adopted. (4) In case of three vendor's distribution of orders (value wise) should be the ratio of 60:25:15 on monthly basis. Suitable mechanism may be worked out to implement this. While deciding the tender.
(5) The distribution should be followed as far as possible. These provisions must be transparently disclosed in the tender.
(6) Vendors offering maximum discount on MRP shall be considered for rate contract, individually for each category-medicines, surgical items, LAB reagents and consumables. If rate contract is to be entered with more than one vendor, discount offered by L1 should be counter-offered to other
selected suitable higher bidders i.e. L2, L3 (as applicable) for acceptance.
(7) The bidders accepting the counter offers shall be finalized for placement of rate contral as per the predefined distribution.

13.	Selection Procedure	Selection done on the basis of: (1). Offers maximum rebate on MRP of medicines, surgical items and consumables etc.(separately) and physical inspection of shops/firm's premises by tender committee. (2) Tender Committee shall evaluate the bids received for eligibility, techno-commercial suitability and financial suitability of the bids and give its recommendations to the Tender Accepting Authority for its consideration through convener of the committee. Rate contracts shall be placed as per the acceptance of the Accepting Authority.
