Sub: Expedite the finalization of cases pending with RIOs.

It has come to the notice of CVC that a large number of DAR cases arising out of CBI/Vigilance investigation are pending with RIOs for longer periods. In this regard Commission vide letter No.0019/MISC/010/438999 dated 18.11.19 has suggested certain measures for expeditious disposal of pending cases as below:-

- a) In cases, where the DA decided long back to keep the RDA in abeyance, the present DA's may be advised to reconsider the decision in view of the present scenario/progress of the case.
- b) There may be cases where there is delay in furnishing defence documents to the CO. In such cases, the respective DAs may be advised to take all necessary steps to provide the CO with the documents. In case, the documents cannot be made available for some reason, the IO may be advised accordingly.
- c) There may be cases, where the IO has completed inquiry but the CO has not submitted his defence brief even after stipulated time. In such cases the IO may be advised to proceed without the defence brief after having provided sufficient time as per principles of natural justice.
- d) There are cases, where the IO has submitted report after completion of inquiry, but the DA has not taken a view for the reason that Vigilance comments are awaited. In such cases, the DAs may be advised not to unduly wait for Vigilance comments. The DAs may also be advised not to refer the IO's report to Vigilance in a routine manner. Since the Zonal Vigilance submits all the facts before issuance of the charge-sheet, the IO's report should be referred to Zonal Vigilance only in very exceptional cases. In this regard para 530 of IRVM 2018, issued vide Correction Slip 01 dated 04.10.19 may be followed.
- e) It is also seen that some cases are pending with the Establishment Dte or the DAs in Railway Board for quite some time. These cases may be pursued vigorously by concerned P-branch of Zonal Railways. However, such correspondences may also be mailed to Board Vigilance for following up as per para 802.3 of IRVM issued vide Correction Slip-01.
- f) In very old cases, where relevant files/documents are not available, the concerned DA may be advised to take a final view regarding continuation/closure, duly considering overall circumstances of the case. The final view of DA along with PED's recommendations may be intimated to the Commission.

Above suggestions may be implemented for expeditious disposal of pending cases and necessary action in this regard may be taken.
