PLACES OF PILGRIMAGE/HISTORICAL IMPORTANCE

- ▶ **Gaya** – Gaya is an ancient city and is famous for **Vishnu Pad Temple**, attracting a large number of tourists especially during 14 days' **Pitrapaksh Mela** when lakhs of pilgrims visit Gaya from all over the country to offer Pinda Dan to their ancestors.
- ▶ **Bodh Gaya** – Situated 17 kms from Gaya, Bodh Gaya is a historical place of Buddhist Pilgrimage and is famous for **Budhha Temple**. A large number of Indian and Foreign tourists visit Bodh Gaya especially during winters.
- ▶ **Sasaram** – This historical place was the capital of Sher Shah Suri. The Tomb of Sher Shah Suri was constructed here in the year 1545.
- ▶ **Deo Road** – Famous for Sun temple of Deo Road.
- ▶ **Mughalsarai** – Mughalsarai connects to all parts of the country by Rail Transport and is close to the holy city Varanasi. People drop in here to visit Varanasi and Sarnath, which is another historical place of Buddhist Pilgrimage.
