JOINT PROCEDURE ORDER NO.1/2009

**Sub: Testing of Competency of Assistant Station Master/Station Master/
Dy. Station Superintendent/Panel Operator.**

1. There has been increasing incidences of failure caused by wrong operation of operating panel of Panel Interlocking, Route Relay Interlocking and Electronic Interlocking installations, specially during emergency operation e.g., Route cancellation, Emergency Point Operation, Emergency Route Release, Emergency operation of Point etc.
2. Para 21.18.6 of Signal Engineering Manual part-II stipulates that the "Panel shall be operated by Station Master/ Panel Operator who shall possess a panel competency certificate issued jointly by Traffic Inspector and Section Engineer (signal) of the section duly countersigned by assistant officer of Traffic and Signal Department."
3. It has therefore been decided that every Asst. Station Master/Station Master/Dy. SS/ Panel Operator who operates operating panel of Panel Interlocking, Route Relay Interlocking and Electronic Interlocking shall be subjected to an overall competency test to be conducted jointly by the Senior Section Engineer (Signal) or District Incharge of Signal and the Traffic Inspector of the section once in three years. If any Asst. Station Master/Station Master/Dy. SS/Panel Operator failed in the test, he will be trained two days on operating panel of Panel Interlocking, Route Relay Interlocking and Electronic Interlocking jointly by Signal & Traffic Supervisor and then issue such competency certificate.
4. To enable the competency to be checked round the year, the entire programme shall be uniformly distributed over the year. Sr.DSTE and Sr.DOM shall monitor the progress of this strictly.
5. A monthly progress report shall be sent to CSTE and COM.
