Ministry of Railways in the collaboration with Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD), Government of India has launched a "Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Railways to ensure Care and Protection of Children in contact with Railway" on 5th March, 2015. SOP has identified 1000 major Railway Stations including Patna Railway Station for formation and functioning of child protection mechanisms.

2. The SOP authorizes Child Help Group (CHG) and Child Help Desk (CHD) at the railway stations to set and ensure the mechanism for care and protection of children at and around railway stations. Training/orientation for Railway Personnel is an integral part of this SOP.

3. With a view to increase awareness amongst different stake holders, The Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD), the nodal Ministry, has directed the NCPCR to sensitize Railways/GRP/RPF officials at divisional and station level towards care and protection of children coming in contact with Railways. As you may be aware, the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) is a statutory body for dealing with protection of child rights and related matters.

NCPCR has decided to conduct 6 regional training workshops at Mumbai, Delhi, Bangalore, Kolkata Guwahati and Nagpur for the Railway officials on this issue. In collaboration with "Railway Children India" an NGO (www.railwaychildren.org.uk). The objective of these workshops is to orient all the duty bearers of Railways at stations and divisional level (as mentioned in aforesaid SOP) to understand clearly the JJ system, the SOP, their roles and responsibilities and the functions of others in order to bring about an effective system of child protection for creating child-friendly railway stations.

5. A workshop is being organized in Kolkata on 15th March, 2016 at Conference Hall, Administrative Training Institute, Block-FC, Sector-III, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700106. The said workshop will start at 09:30 a.m. and will conclude by 1:30 p.m. followed by lunch. Accommodation for outstations participants for one night on 14th March, 2016 shall be available at Administrative Training Institute, Block-FC, Sector-III, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700106, if required by the participants.

6. It is requested that the following officials of Danapur Railway Division and Patna Railway Station may be deputed to attend the aforesaid workshops:

- i. Divisional level coordinating officers as mentioned in section: 10 of aforesaid SOP i.e ADRM, Sr. DSC, Sr. DCM, and Sr. DEN (Coordination);
- ii. Station Manager, Inspector RPF, SHO GRP and Sr. Section Engineer (work) (along with their cutting edge staff) as Members of Child Help Group (CHD) formed at Patna Railway Station as mentioned in section 1.2 of aforesaid SOP.
