Sub:- Selection for the post of Assistant Signal & Telecom Engineer (Group'B') in
Pay Band Rs. 9300-34800/- (PB-2) Grade Pay – 4800/ against 70% quota.

With the approval of General Manager it has been decided to hold a selection for formation of the consolidated panel of 06 persons(UR-02, SC-02 & ST-02) for two selection period i.e 02 persons(UR-Nil, SC-01 & ST-01) for first selection of the vacancy period 01.01.2014 and 04 persons (UR-02, SC-01 & ST-01) for second selection of the vacancy period 01.07 2016 for the post of Assistant Signal & Telecom Engineer (Group 'B') against 70% quota over E.C. Railway.

A panel shall be prepared for each of the selection. Both the panels should be consolidated by placing the panel of the earlier period above the one for the next and so on.

There will be only one written examination for both selection periods promotion made on the basis of consolidated panel will have only prospective effect.

(1) TENTATIVE DATE OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION

- (a) Date of Written Examination – 25.08.2017
- (b) Time – 11.30 to 14.30
- (c) Venue – General Manager's office, East Central Railway/Hajipur

Normally there is no provision for holding absentee written examination. However, in exceptional circumstances, where sufficient and satisfactory reasons beyond control of candidate(s) are available, (viz either the candidate is under RMC or he was not spared by his controlling officer due to administrative reasons), with the approval of competent authority, only such candidates may be allowed to appear in absentee written examination. It will be responsibility of the candidate to advise reasons of absence through controlling officer to Dy.CPO/Gaz/E.C.Railway/Hajipur within 03 days from the date of written examination. In case of failure to comply the above instructions by the candidate, he/she will not be allowed to appear in the absentee written examination, if held, assuming that reasons are not beyond the control of candidate.



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- (2) The above selection will be based on candidate's performance both in written examination, viva-voce and Record of Service. Only the candidates, who qualify in the written examination and found medically fit for safety category of ASTE(Gr."B") as prescribed in Indian Railway Medical Manual will be called for viva-voce test. The placement of the candidates in the panel based on their performance in the written examination/viva-voce/record of service will be as per extant procedure of Railway Board's instructions.
- (3) The cut-off date for eligibility of candidates for first selection period and second selection period are 01.01.2014 and 01.07.2016 respectively for both 70% selection and corresponding 30% LDCE (to be notified later).
- (4) The list of candidates /staff of S & T Department who are eligible to appear in the 70% selection and stand- by list prepared on the basis of integrated seniority are enclosed as Annexure-'A' and Annexure-'B' respectively in order of seniority.

While preparing the above said list of Annexure-A and Annexure-B, the provisions contained in Board's letter No. E(GP)85/1/78 dated 10.09.86, E(GP)87/2/72 dated 11.01.88 and E(GP)99/2/22 dated 29.03.10 have been taken care of.

Representation, if any, against the seniority position, omission/submission of any name may be sent to Dy.CPO/HRD/HJP through proper channel with a copy directly docketing to Dy.CPO/Gaz/ECR/HJP within 15 days from issue of this notification. No representation will be entertained after the stipulated period.

The willingness/unwillingness of all the eligible candidates enlisted in Annexure-'A' and Annexure-'B' should be communicated to Dy.CPO/Gaz/ECR/HJP through special messenger by 10.07.2017.


- (5) Sr.DPOs/Personnel Officers of the Divisions/Units are requested to ensure that the Staff Welfare Inspector/Sectional staff welfare inspector should be deputed to obtain willingness/unwillingness on the prescribed proforma enclosed as Annexure-C from the candidates (including on deputation/leave/sick). If any candidate refuses to provide willingness/unwillingness, the deputed staff welfare inspector should submit a written report regarding non-submission of option by the candidate. Such candidates will be treated as unwilling for the above selection.

The controlling officers are also requested to co-ordinate with the Personnel Officers and staff, to complete the above exercise within time frame.

- (6) **Syllabus :** The written examination for 70% selection will consist of only one paper with maximum marks of 150 and Qualifying marks of 90. As per para 204.03 of IREM Vol-1 15 marks out of total of 150 marks for testing the Professional ability, will be on the subject of official language policy and rules, which will not be compulsory to attempt. Since ASTE is safety post, **no relaxation** is admissible to SC/ST candidates as per extant rule.

As per IREM Vol-1 Para 204.2, no syllabus has been prescribed.

The question paper will be bilingual i.e. Hindi & English as per extant instructions. However, it will be candidate's choice to write in English or in Hindi.


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(7) **Pre-Selection Coaching for SC/ST Candidates:**

In terms of Railway Board's letter No. E(MPP)96/3/23 dated 21.07.2000 mandatory Pre-selection coaching classes of 3-4 weeks (21 working days) for SC/ST eligible candidates, will be arranged before conducting written examination by the department concerned. CSTE will nominate the in-charge of Pre-Selection Coaching. The in-charge will also intimate the date and venue of the pre-selection coaching in due course.

If any SC/ST candidate refuses to undergo pre selection coaching, a written undertaking should be obtained from him. The controlling officer(s) should ensure that the SC/ST candidates under their control are spared without fail on time to participate in the Pre-selection coaching. The SC/ST candidate(s) are also advised to insist their controlling officers in their own interest to spare them for the said coaching.

(7.1) **Duty of the in-charge of Pre-Selection Coaching (To be nominated by CSTE):-**

- i) To inform in writing through special messenger to the concerned SC/ST employee with details of date, time & venue of coaching.
- ii) To obtain in writing unwillingness for coaching, if any, from the concerned SC/ST employees.
- iii) To arrange sparing of the candidates in case any problem occurs.
- vi) To chalk out coaching schedule.

(7.2) **Duty of Controlling Officer:-**

To spare the candidates under their control without fail on time with the direction to participate in the Pre-selection coaching.

(7.3) **Duty of concerned SC/ST applicant:-**

- i) To manage their sparing from duty by insisting their controlling officers in their own interest.
- ii) If any problem occurs in sparing, the candidate should report in writing to concerned in-charge of Pre-Selection coaching on the same date. No representation will be entertained in case of failure to report to the concerned in-charge of pre-selection coaching and it will deemed to be refusal for the same.
- iii) Failure of concerned SC/ST employees to avail pre-selection coaching on any account including leave etc. will be considered on their part.
- iv) No appeal will be entertained by GM(P)/ECR office after completion of pre-selection coaching.

After completion of coaching, the in-charge of the pre-selection coaching will give a written report along with all supporting papers including attendance sheet of SC/ST participants to Dy.CPO/G/HJP latest by 21.08.17 for records and taking further necessary action.

(8) The Controlling/ Authorized officer should ensure the issue of individual sparing letters duly attesting specimen signature of the candidate on the sparing letter. The candidates without proper sparing letter will not be allowed to appear in the written examination.


(9) The concerned Personnel branch officer & controlling officers should ensure submission of service records and ACRs/APARs of last 05 years and DAR/SPE/Vigilance/RP(UP) Clearance in respect of staff declared qualified for the viva-voce in due course immediately after publication of the result of written examination through special messenger to Dy.CPO/Gaz/ECR/HJP.

(10) The above selection will be held as per procedure laid down in Master Circular No. 68, governing promotion from Gr. 'C' to Gr. 'B' issued by Railway Board and the instructions issued time to time. The said Master Circular is available on website www.indianrailways.gov.in....>Ministry of Railways...>Railway Board>Railway Board Directorates... >Establishment...>E(GP)circular>Master Circular. The department/ division/unit should ensure the compliance of instructions of item 15 of Master Circular- 68.
