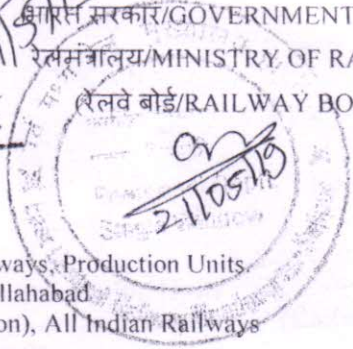

Sub: Minimum rates of wages and variable dearness allowance w.e.f. 01.04.2019

A copy each of Orders No. (i) 1/8(1)/2019-LS-II, (ii) 1/8(2)/2019-LS-II, (iii) No.1/8(3)/2019-LS-II, (iv) No.1/8(4)/2018 LS-II (v) No.1/8(5)/2019 -LS.II (vi)1/8(6)/2019-LS-II and (vii) 1/8(7)/2019-LS-II dated 27.03.2019 revising the rates of variable dearness allowance for contract workers engaged in (i) Agriculture (ii) Gypsum Mines, Barytes Mines, Bauxite Mines, Manganese Mines, China Clay Mines, Kyanite Mines, Copper Mines, Clay Mines, Magnesite, Mines, White Clay Mines, Stone Mines, Steatite Mines (including the mines producing Soap Stones and Tale), Ochre Mines, Asbestos Mines, Fire Clay Mines, Chromite Mines, Quartzite Mines, Quartz Mines, Silica Mines, Graphite Mines, Felspar Mines, Laterite Mines, Dolomite Mines, Red Oxide Mines, Wolfram Mines Iron Mines Ore Mines, Granite Mines, Rock Phosphate Mines, Hematite Mines Marble and Calcite Mines, Uranium Mines, Mica Mines, Lignite Mines, Gravel Mines, Slate Mines and Magnetite Mines (iii) Construction or Maintenance of Roads or runways or in Building Operations including Laying Down Underground electric, wireless, Radio, Television, Telephone, Telegraph and Overseas Communication Cables and Similar other Underground cabling work, Electric lines, Water supply lines and Sewerage Pipe Lines (iv) Stone mines (v) Employment of sweeping and cleaning excluding activities prohibited under the Employment of Manual Scavengers and Construction of Dry Latrines (Prohibition) Act, 1993 (vi) Watch and Ward (With arms and without arms) and (vii) Loading and unloading in (i) Goods sheds, parcel offices of Railways, (ii) other goods-sheds, godowns, warehouses and other similar employments; (iii) Docks and Ports; And (iv) Passengers goods and Cargo Carried out at Airports (Both International and Domestic). The rates are applicable w.e.f. 01.04.2019.

2. Railways, being Principal Employer are required to ensure that the contractors are complying with the provisions of the Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970 and Minimum wages Act, 1948 strictly and arranging prescribed minimum wages to the contract labourers.

ORDER

[In exercise of the powers conferred by Central Government vide Notification No. S.O. 186(E) dated 19th January, 2017 of the Ministry of Labour and Employment the undersigned hereby revise the rates of Variable Dearness Allowance for the employees employed in **Agriculture** w.e.f. 01.04.2019 on the basis of the average Consumer Price Index for Industrial workers reaching 301.33 from 288.33 as on 31.12.2018 (Base 2001-100) and thereby resulting in an increase of 13 points. The revised Variable Dearness Allowance as under shall be payable from 01.04.2019:-


| Category of worker | Rates of V.D.A. Area wise per day (in Rupees) | | |

| Unskilled | 38 | 36 | 36 |
| Semi-Skilled/Unskilled Supervisory | 43 | 38 | 36 |

| Highly Skilled | 50 | 47 | 43 |

Therefore, the minimum rates of wages including the basic rates and Variable Dearness Allowance payable w.e.f. 01.04.2019 to the employees working in Agriculture shall be as under:-

| Highly Skilled | 438+50=488 | 407+47=454 | 364+43=407 |

The VDA has been rounded off to the next higher rupee as per the decision of the Minimum Wages Central Advisory Board.

The classification of workers under different categories will be same as in Part-I of the notification, whereas classification of cities will be same as in the Part-II of the notification dated 19th January, 2017. The present classification of cities into areas A, B & C is enclosed at Annexure I for ready reference.
