- 1.0 HQ Scrap Sale Progress Meeting is planned to schedule once on every month in order to achieve the internal scrap sale target of Rs. 400 Cr. as per the review meeting held on 02.12.2024 in the chamber of GM/ECR. .
- 2.0 The meeting was convened by Dy.CMM-IV under guidance of CMM-I. CMM-I has chaired the meeting and instructed to increase scrap sale by taking initiative at all steps of TMS Scrap lots and make the division scrap free under Mission Zero Scrap.
- 3.0 There is lagging in uploading of mapped/verified lots into TMS by all the divisions, as unoffered quantity out of total mapped scrap P. Way qty. are high i.e. approx. 19000 MT as on date. Therefore, it has been instructed to approach Sr. DENs on regular basis to take necessary action for uploading the mapped quantity into TMS. It is also essential to chase at custodian level and to know the reason where the scrap mapped is stuck up and why it is withhold because these lots should be mopped within 3 months by early uploading into TMS, publishing in auction catalogue and fetching scrap sale.

In view of the above, all Sr.DMMs are advised to plan good strategy and tactics for achieving the revised internal scrap sale target of Rs. 400 Cr. in FY: 2024-25.
